Fun Lunch FAQs



At RBE we use MunchaLunch to facilitate ordering for fun lunch and other fundraisers/events. Scan the QR code on the left to go to the MunchaLunch website to register or log in to your existing account. If you already have a MunchaLunch account, please log in and update the division and classroom teacher for each of your children to ensure smooth delivery.

How do I order fun lunch?

To order fun lunch, please use this link: <https://munchalunch.com//login> When ordering a fun lunch for your child(ren) please note the deadlines for ordering. We have to pre-order 10 days in advance so restaurants can prepare for the large orders we submit, especially since we now have over 600 students in our school. It is for that reason that we cannot accept last minute orders. Fun lunch ordering is done in sessions, so please ensure that you order each term, so your child(ren) doesn't miss out!

What happens after I order?

It is imperative that you successfully order and pay for your child(ren)'s fun lunch orders within 6 hours of creating it. Munch-a-Lunch will not save orders anymore.

Munch-a-Lunch also sends a reminder email the day before the fun lunch day, with a list of what you have ordered for your child(ren). If you do not get this email, it means your child(ren) will NOT be receiving a fun lunch.

What if I have to cancel a paid order?

If you have to cancel a paid order before the order deadline for that fun lunch day please email bulpittfunlunch@gmail.com so we can cancel the order and issue you a credit on Munchalunch. Unfortunately, if you have to cancel a paid order after the order deadline, we will not be able to cancel or credit the fun lunch as we have already submitted the order to the restaurant.

What if my child is absent?

If your child will be absent on Fun Lunch Day, please come to the PAC kitchen between 12 and 12:30 pm to pick it up. If you cannot pick it up, please consider it as a donation as there are no refunds.

What to do on a fun lunch day?

Connect with your children the morning of fun lunch to remind them what to expect for lunch – or if they will not be receiving.

Double check your email to see if you got a reminder email from Munch-a-Lunch the day before (usually Thursday morning) about what your child(ren) should be receiving. If you didn't get this email, please make sure you pack a lunch for your child(ren).

What if I notice an error?

If on the fun lunch day, your child notices an error with their order, please have them communicate with their teacher, so that the teacher can either come to the PAC kitchen, or send your child there for assistance. We will do our best to make sure the error is corrected, so your child does not go without lunch.

If your child comes home and communicates an error to you, please email Christina or Zoe at bulpittfunlunch@gmail.com with your child(ren)'s name(s), division number(s), and the nature of the error. In future, please let your child know to communicate with their teacher right away, so that the error can be corrected promptly.
